





## Platinum Jubilee at St Mary's Church 2<sup>nd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> June

The Church will be at the heart of Welford's celebration of the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. As usual the church will be open for visitors during each of the four days of the festival. In the church there will be a '70 years of Welford' exhibition and displays from the School\*. National events will be streamed and old local films shown.

Teas/coffees will be served with cakes from 10:30am to 12:00 and again from 3pm to 4:30 on Thursday, Friday and Saturday morning (times may need to flex to fit in with national events once timings are known).

On Saturday afternoon the 9 trees contributed by groups and individuals to the Queen's Green Canopy will be planted in the Churchyard Extension and blessed by our Rector.

There will be a special Platinum Jubilee service on Sunday morning at 11:00AM.

\*This will include a reproduction of their flag design that has been selected to be among the 200 flags paraded along the Mall in the 'River of Hope' on Sunday as part of the Jubilee Pageant.
